
SAVANNA HAYDEN



Located in Rochester New York, the Toy Hall of Fame recognizes the contributions of toys and games that have sustained their popularity for many years. Criteria for induction include: icon status (the toy is widely recognized, respected, and remembered); longevity (more than a passing fad); discovery (fosters learning, creativity, or discovery); and innovation (profoundly changed play or toy design). Many inductees are timeless classics, that young and old have enjoyed during playtime for generations. Others are non-traditional selections, but nonetheless, have inspired hours of creativity in the simplest of forms, including a stick, sand, and even a plain cardboard box! Since 1999, 81 toys have been selected for induction into the National Toy Hall of Fame, and many of them will be featured* here this evening. How many did you own and love growing up?

The Powerpuff Girls is an American superhero animated television series created by animator Craig McCracken and produced by Hanna-Barbera (later Cartoon Network Studios) for Cartoon Network and distributed by Warner Bros. Domestic Television. The show centers on Blossom, Bubbles, and Buttercup, three kindergarten-aged girls with superpowers. The girls all live in the fictional city of Townsville with their father and creator, a scientist named Professor Utonium, and are frequently called upon by the city's mayor to help fight nearby criminals and other enemies using their powers. From 1999 to 2002, Trendmasters made Powerpuff Girls dolls and action figures. The franchise made nearly \$1 billion in retail sales by 2002 according to Cartoon Network.

LEGO NINJAGO

Lego Ninjago is a Lego theme that was created in 2011 and a flagship brand of The Lego Group. It is the first theme to be based on ninja since the discontinuation of the Lego Ninja theme in 2000. Whilst it retains some elements of the previous theme, it is based on a more detailed storyline set with-in a fantasy world, primarily underpinned by the computer-animated television series Ninjago. The theme focuses on a group of six teenage ninja, led by the legendary Green Ninja, Lloyd Garmadon. The main ninja characters are defined in the story as "Elemental Masters", which means that they each possess elemental powers. The ninja are trained in the fictional martial art of "Spinjitzu" by their ancient and wise teacher, Master Wu, giving them the ability to fight against the forces of evil.

POLLY POCKETS

Polly Pocket is a toy line of dolls and accessories first founded and designed by Chris Wiggs in 1983 for his daughter Kate. Using a makeup powder compact, he fashioned a small house for the tiny doll. The original Polly Pocket toys were plastic cases that opened to form a dollhouse or other playset with Polly Pocket figurines less than an inch tall. The dolls folded in the middle, like the case, and had circular bases which slotted into holes in the case interior, allowing them to stand securely at particular points in the house. This was particularly useful for moving points in the case. Because the dolls were so small, sometimes they came enclosed in pendants or large rings instead of the more typical playset cases.

POWER RANGERS

Power Rangers is an American entertainment and merchandising franchise built around a live-action superhero television series, based on the Japanese tokusatsu franchise Super Sentai. The first Power Rangers entry, Mighty Morphin Power Rangers, debuted on August 28, 1993, and helped launch the Fox Kids programming block of the 1990s. Each series revolves around a team of youths recruited and trained by a mentor to morph into the eponymous Power Rangers, able to use special powers and pilot immense assault machines, called Zords, to overcome the periodic antagonists. In the original series Mighty Morphin, the wizard Zordon recruits "teenagers with attitude" against Rita Repulsa. The series catapulted into popular culture along with a line of action figures and other toys by Bandai. By 2001, the media franchise had generated over \$6 billion in toy sales.

BARBIE

Barbie is a fashion doll manufactured by American toy company Mattel, Inc. American businesswoman Ruth Handler is credited with the creation of the doll, inspired by watching her daughter Barbara play with paper dolls, and noticed that she often enjoyed giving them adult roles. At the time, most children's toy dolls were representations of infants. Ruth based her initial design on a German toy doll called Bild Lilli. The doll would go on to make its debut at the American International Toy Fair in New York City on March 9, 1959, which is also used as Barbie's official birthday. Barbie is the figurehead of a brand of Mattel dolls and accessories, including other family members and collectible dolls. Barbie has been an important part of the toy fashion doll market for over six decades. The brand has expanded into a long-running multimedia franchise since the late 1980s, including video games and GGI/computeranimated films. Barbie and her best male friend Ken have been described as two most popular dolls in the world.

ARMY MEN

Army men, or plastic soldiers, are toy soldiers that are about 5 cm (2.0 in) tall and most commonly molded from olive green, relatively unbreakable plastic. The first American plastic toy soldiers were made by Bergen Toy & Novelty Co. (Beton for short) in 1938. They are equipped with a variety of weapons, typically from World War II to the current era, often depicting the 1964 Vietnam-era M-16 rifle with fixed M7 bayonet. These include rifles, machine guns, submachine guns, sniper rifles, pistols, grenades, flamethrowers, mortars, and bazookas. They may also have radio men, binocular scouts, and minesweepers. Unlike the more expensive toy soldiers available in hobby shops, army men are sold at low prices in discount stores and supermarkets in bulk packaging

LITE-BRITE

Lite-Brite is a toy that was originally marketed in 1967. It consists of a light box with small colored plastic pegs that fit into a panel and illuminate to create a lit picture, by either using one of the included templates or creating a "freeform" image on a blank sheet of black paper. Lite-Brite allows the artist to create a glowing picture by punching multi-colored translucent plastic pegs through opaque black paper. Using a standard light bulb, the light is blocked by the black paper except where the pegs conduct the light. When lit, the pegs have an appearance similar to that of LEDs.

HOT WHEELS

Hot Wheels is an American brand of scale model cars introduced by American toymaker Mattel in 1968. The original Hot Wheels were made by Elliot Handler. Handler discovered his son Kenneth playing with Matchbox cars and decided to create a line to compete with Matchbox. Hot Wheels were originally conceived by Handler to be more like "hot rod" cars, as compared to Matchbox cars which were generally small-scale models of production cars. The first line of Hot Wheels Cars, known as The Original Sweet 16 was manufactured in 1968. These were the first of the Red Line Series, named for the tires which had a red pin stripe on their sides. In addition to the cars themselves, Mattel produced a racing track set (sold separately). Though it would be updated throughout the years, the original track consisted of a series of bright orange road sections, pieced together to form an oblong, circular race track, with "superchargers" stations through which cars passed on the tracks, featuring battery-powered spinning wheels, which would propel the cars along the tracks.

RUBBER DUCKIES

A rubber duck or a rubber duckie is a toy shaped like a stylized duck, generally yellow with a flat base. It may be made of rubber or rubber-like material such as vinyl plastic.[1] Rubber ducks were invented in the late 1800s when it became possible to more easily shape rubber. The earliest rubber ducks were made from harder rubber when manufacturers began using Charles Goodyear's invention, vulcanized rubber. Consequently, these solid rubber ducks were not capable of floating and were instead intended as chew toys. When they were reproduced as a floating toy, they evolved as a device to improve developmental skills in children during water play. The yellow rubber duck has achieved an iconic status in Western pop culture and is often symbolically linked to bathing. In 2013, the rubber duck was inducted into the Toy Hall of Fame, a museum in Rochester, New York, along with the game of chess

EASY BAKE OVEN

The Easy-Bake Oven is a working toy oven that Kenner introduced in 1963. The Easy Bake Oven was invented by Norman Shapiro, a salesman at Kenner Products Company. He got the idea for the oven from the pretzel machines in the NYC Subway which used lightbulbs to heat the pretzels. The original toy used a pair of ordinary incandescent light bulbs as a heat source; current versions use a true heating element. The oven comes with packets of cake mix and small round pans. Additional mixes can be purchased separately. After water is added to the mix in the pan, it is pushed into the oven through a slot. After cooking, the cake is pushed out through a slot in the other end. In its first year of production, Kenner sold 500,000 Easy-Bake Ovens in the first year of production.

STAR WARS FIGURINES

Kenner Star Wars action figures are a line of over 100 unique toys, produced and sold from 1978 to 1985, among a total of more than 300 million Star Wars action figures sold then. Star Wars was the first film to successfully market toys based on the movie. Although the original Star Wars film had been released in May 1977, Kenner was unprepared for the unprecedented response to the film and the high demand for toys, mainly due to George Lucas's unwillingness to provide character/vehicle designs for fear his creations would be plagiarized by movie/tv competitors. Unable to build sufficient stock in time for the lucrative Christmas market, they instead sold an "Early Bird Certificate Package" which included a certificate which could be mailed to Kenner and redeemed for four Star Wars action figures. The first four figures to be distributed were Luke Skywalker, Princess Leia, Chewbacca and R2-D2] The box also contains a diorama display stand, some stickers, and a Star Wars fan club membership card

TOY FUN FACT:

John Lloyd Wright invented Lincoln Logs after working in Japan with his father, renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright. The mold for the toy was based on the architecture of the Imperial Hotel in Tokyo, designed by the inventor's father. The foundation of the hotel was designed with interlocking log beams, which made the structure "earthquake-proof" and one of the few buildings to remain standing after the 1923 Great Kanto Earthquake that crumbled Tokyo.

STRAWBERRY SHORTCAKE

Strawberry Shortcake is a cartoon character originally created by Barbi Sargent, who was then working as a freelance artist for American Greetings. The character first appeared on a Laurel Valentine's Day Greeting card in 1972–1973. At the time, the character was simply called Girl with a Daisy or Strawberry Girl and was depicted holding a daisy while wearing an orange bonnet with a strawberry print on it. In 1979, toy manufacturer Kenner Products licensed the character and released the first Strawberry Shortcake doll. The Strawberry Shortcake line of characters each had their own fruit or dessert-themed name with clothing to match the fruit or dessert-themed name, and they each had a dessert or fruit-named pet. Like the Strawberry Shortcake doll, all the other characters' dolls had hair scented to match their dessert theme. The characters lived and played in a magical world known as Strawberryland.

JACK IN THE BOX

A jack-in-the-box is a children's toy that outwardly consists of a box with a crank. When the crank is turned, a music box mechanism in the toy plays a melody. After the crank has been turned a sufficient number of times (such as at the end of the melody), the lid pops open and a figure, usually a clown or jester, pops out of the box. Some jacks-in-the-box open at random times when cranked, making the startle even more effective. Many of those that use "Pop Goes the Weasel" open at the point in the melody when the word "pop" would be sung. In the early 1500s, the first jack-in-the-box was made by a German clockmaker known as Claus. Claus built a wooden box, with metal edges and a handle that would pop out an animated devil or "Jack" after cranking the handle. It was built as a gift for a local prince's fifth birthday. After seeing this toy, other nobles re-quested their own "Devils-in-a-box" for their children.

Monster High is an American multimedia-supported fashion doll franchise created by toy designer Garrett Sander and launched by Mattel in 2010. Aimed at children aged 7 to 14, the franchise features characters inspired by monster movies, sci-fi horror, thriller fiction, folklore, myths and popular culture, centering around the adventures of the teenage children of monsters and other mythical creatures attending a high school of the same name. Over 750 different dolls have been released since its 2010 launch. Some dolls, particularly the ones which were released a long time ago or in limited quantity, are rare, collectible, and therefore expensive. Most Monster High dolls were marketed to children as toys to play with, but some "collector's edition" dolls, priced higher and aimed at an older audience, were also made. The franchise has also transcended into Animated specials and films, as well as video games and Young Adult Novels.



Transparency of the Blue Team Mural Sketch



PENNY/CHANGE WARS



Each year, as part of the Spirit Night festivities, the Blue and White teams compete in Penny Wars. The way Penny Wars works is each team has a bucket that they place Pennies into. Pennies count positively towards their total. But the other team can place silver coins and dollar bills into their bucket, which then subtracts from their total. This year, the funds raised from Spirit Night Change Wars will be helping a CEC run chapter of Best Buddies, an organization whose goal is providing inclusion and friendship to those with disabilities. Their goal is making the world more welcoming to people with Intellectual and developmental Disabilities (IDD), one friendship, one job, and one life-changing connection at a time. On April 29, the Best Buddies CEC Board Members, along with any interested CEC students, will be participating in the Best Buddies Friendship Walk in King of Prussia. Best Buddies programs empower the special abilities of people with IDD by helping them form meaningful friendships with their peers, secure successful jobs, live independently, improve public speaking, self-advocacy and communication skills, and feel valued by society. Congrats to the CEC community in helping raise funds and awareness for this cause this year.






