KEEP FOR REFERENCE

All students who drive to school must complete a registration form with the essential information. This form will be kept on file in the Assistant Principal for Student Life Office.

ONLY THOSE STUDENTS WITH A CURRENT PARKING PERMIT ARE PERMITTED TO USE THE SCHOOL LOT. ALL OTHERS IN VIOLATION WILL BE TOWED AT OWNERS EXPENSE.

Hang tags must be displayed on the rear view mirror. The number on the hang tag must match the number on the spot. The school is not responsible for the car or its contents. If hang tag is not displayed, car will be stickered and possibly towed.

SCHOOL BUSES AND PEDESTRIANS MUST BE GIVEN THE RIGHT OF WAY AT ALL TIMES.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

- 1) Use only the designated entrance and exit.
- 2) Students must drive directly to their assigned place and not unload passengers
- 3) No Speeding — maintain 5 m.p.h. throughout the parking lot
- 4) No sitting in cars after arriving – go directly into the school:
 - No loitering on lot after dismissal.
- 5) Do not use cars on the parking lot for smoking.
- 6) STUDENTS MAY NOT GO TO CARS DURING THE DAY WITHOUT THE DIRECT PERMISSION OF THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL FOR STUDENT LIFE.
- 7) Students are to observe normal traffic laws at all times. Cruising the lot, riding on the hood, bumper, trunk, or back of a pick-up, hanging out of the window, and dangerous behaviors will result in disciplinary action and loss of parking privilege.
- 8) Any student reported to the school as driving recklessly on the school grounds or in the vicinity of the school either before or after school or before or after a school sponsored event will be liable to be denied parking privilege.
- 9) Parking permits are not Transferrable.
- 10) Student vehicles may be subject to search. Refer to student handbook on Universal Search Policy.
- 11) Any student with 15 unexcused lates may result in the loss of parking privileges.

Note: No refund if you lose your parking privileges for violating regulations.
