NOTES FROM THE DIRECTOR

"Summer in Beaumont sur Mer... the night is warm... the trees are in bloom..."

Welcome to our little slice of the French Riviera right here in Fairless Hills, PA, as Conwell-Egan Catholic High School proudly presents: Dirty Rotten Scoundrels!

Dirty Rotten Scoundrels tells the story of two con men and their hilarious adventures on the French Riviera in the 1980's. The show is based on the 1988 film of the same name, starring Steve Martin and Michael Caine. The stage version, with book by Jeffrey Lane and music and lyrics by David Yazbek, premiered in San Diego in 2004. It opened on Broadway in 2005, starring Jon Lithgow as Lawrence, Norbert Leo Butz as Freddy, and Sherie Rene Scott as Christine. The show ran on Broadway for about a year and a half, earning a staggering 11 Tony nominations. The show toured nationally from 2006-2008, and remains a popular production for theaters across the country.

Since the original film was set in 1988, we have decided to set this show in the 1980's, as is evident by the costumes and props, as well as the general color palate. The more contemporary references you may notice in some of the lines and songs we treat like a breaking of the fourth wall, something that happens quite often in this show. The show's light-hearted and comedic plot is emphasized in Yazbek's musical score, highlighting various musical styles and musical theatre traditions. His musical writing is decidedly jazz influenced, as can be heard in "Give Them What They Want" and "Dirty Rotten Number," but he also references time-honored Broadway traditions ("Oklahoma"), 80's rock ballads ("Love is My Legs"), as well as lyrical Broadway ballads ("Nothing is Too Wonderful to Be True" and "Love Sneaks In"). There really is a bit of everything in the score.

Working on this production has been especially meaningful to me, as it was the last musical I ever performed in (Cheltenham High School, 2012); and it is even more meaningful to be able to direct it alongside Luke Sullivan, who was also a part of that 2012 cast. I feel so fortunate to work alongside such a positive and dedicated production team, and most of all, with such a hard-working and vibrantly talented group of students. The students in the cast and crew have taken this show and run with it, and their countless hours of hard work and dedication will be evident to you as they take the stage today.

So, thank you for spending your evening or afternoon with us today. As we kick off the 5-year anniversary celebration of the opening of the Grace Danaher Performing Arts Center, I invite you to sit back, relax, and get ready to laugh as Conwell-Egan Catholic High School proudly presents: *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels!*
