FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION IS NOW OPEN



The application for Financial Aid is available through FACTS, the same website you use to pay tuition. Visit <https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid> to apply online.

After completing your application, families will be provided options (mail, fax, or online upload) for submitting their supporting tax documents (2021 tax return; FACTS will contact families who do not file a tax return to confirm what documents they need to provide).

- 2023-2024 application opens up October 1, 2022
- \$35 application fee per family
- Priority deadline: 12/31/22. Applications after this date are reviewed on a rolling basis.

- Requires supporting documentation (2021 tax return)

Spirit Night 2023 – TOYS!

There is a Spirit Night Information Meeting for any parent interested in assisting this year set for **Thursday, December 15, at 6 PM in the CEC Cafeteria.**

To the uninitiated who are unfamiliar with Spirit Night - it is an almost entirely student-run activity that brings the student population together in competition. Each year, the students prepare for months, honing their skills to eventually show them off over three wild and crazy nights. From January to March, the

students choreograph dances, build giant themed murals, design intricate costumes, cut music, organize skits and invent fun and challenging games. All of this culminates in three amazing nights – set to take place this year on March 30 - April 1.

Each team holds practice twice a week on their respective nights beginning **Monday, January 9, 2023**, continuing every week up until Spirit Week, the last week of March.

The schedule is as follows:

White Team Practices – Mondays/Wednesdays - 5:30-7:30

- First Practice, Mon. Jan 9

Blue Team Practices – Tuesdays/Thursdays – 5:30-7:30

- First Practice, Tues. Jan 10

For all Freshmen (Class of 2026), the class is split evenly down the middle, dividing the first half of the alphabet onto the White Team, and the second half on the Blue Team. That will be each individual student's team for their four years. This year, the split for each team is as follows:

- Freshmen White Team last name - **Aballa** through **Leonard**
- Freshmen Blue Team last name - **LeSage** through **Zhang**

Any parent interested in volunteering and assisting with Spirit Night Costumes, you must make sure you complete all below clearances and background checks, **and submit them to the school**

These include:

1. **FBI Clearance** -Go to <https://uenroll.identogo.com>. The following codes are needed to register:
 - 1KG6TR - code for (PDE) Pennsylvania Department of Education (non-public schools)
 - 1KG6Y3 - code for (PDE) Pennsylvania Department of Education for Volunteers.
 - **Conwell-Egan ID - #AUN#2-22-09-125-2**
 - You should then click on *Schedule or Manage Appointment* and complete the required information. Payment is to be made at the time of the fingerprinting For fingerprint locations please visit the website: <https://www.identogo.com/locations/pennsylvania>
 - (**If you have lived in Pa for the Past 10 years then you do**NOT** need to have your FBI fingerprints completed. However, you will need to fill out a PA disclosure form.)

2. **Child abuse certificate** - www.compass.state.pa.us/CWIS (Good for 5 years)
3. **State background check** – www.epatch.state.pa.us/home.jsp.
 - Please check off that you are a **Volunteer** when applying for this certificate and there will be no charge. (Good for 5 years)
4. **Safe Environment Part 1 class** (Protect Gods Children, Standards of Ministerial Behavior) (Good Forever) - www.childyouthprotection.org
 - Once you are logged in then click on link for “on-site training” (classes might be virtual)
 - Once completed, submit the class completion form to the main office.
5. **Safe environment Part 2 Certificate** (Mandated Reporter) www.childyouthprotection.org
 - Once logged in click on the link for “online Training”. Submit Certificate to Main Office
