Hello CEC Families,

The second semester is underway, but we cannot seem to be able to escape the snow! Through the unfavorable weather, we have continued to pursue the prospective CEC Class of 2025. All trends point towards enrollment growth again for CEC in the fall of 2021!

We were able to complete two major projects on campus during the first semester: the new turf field and the gymnasium. We are currently in the assessment stage in trying to determine what upgrades can be made to the fields in the back of the building. We also intend on upgrading our Biology and Physics labs in the near future. We firmly believe that the environment plays a major role in the experience our students have while at CEC, so we will continue to invest in our campus.

There are a lot of things going on at CEC right now! Winter sports teams are participating in their PCL seasons. Spirit Night practices are running Monday through Thursday. FROM THE OFFICE OF ACADEMICS

GREAT NEWS, EAGLES:

Our proficiency levels in both Reading and Mathematics have drastically improved from this time last year to this year despite the circumstances. These proficiency levels are assessed through **Performance Series Tests** which are benchmarks administered to students three times per year (fall, winter, spring). In Reading, CEC students proficiency increased 11% (72 --> 83) and in Mathematics we've improved 12% (76-->88). **CEC had the most improvement (one of only two schools to improve) across the entire**

ATTENDANCE

This is a reminder that if your child is unable to attend in-person classes and would like to be virtual on a given day due to illness, a parent or guardian must call the Student Life attendance line(215 945-6200 ext 440) before 7:30am that morning. It is not acceptable for a student to call themselves virtual or out under any circumstance. If communication is not received by a parent or guardian by 7:30am then the student will be marked as an unexcused absence.

Also, the virtual option is reserved for illnesses ONLY, not for transportation issues, recreational or leisure activities, or family trips. The expectation is that students are to be present at CEC on their in-person days. If your child misses a week worth of their in-person days in a given week, a doctor's note is required.

Please be aware that per school policy, if a student is fully virtual they can not participate in extracurricular activities. Also if they are absent or virtual on a in person day. The reason I say this is because a few students that were virtual on an in person day showed up to practice.


Rounding out the week, students were treated to pretzels during lunches, dress down days, and Teacher Swap. We had a great Catholic Schools Week celebration!
