#### FROM THE OFFICE OF TECHNOLOGY



With the 2022-23 school year now underway, I wanted to take a moment to remind everyone that the Safeware (Chromebook) Insurance web portal is now open and will remain open until Friday, October 14, 2021. If you purchased insurance last year (2021-2022), your Chromebook policy expired on Friday, September 4, 2022!

Whether or not you had purchased an insurance policy in the past, please take a moment to read the PDF (available by clicking on the link below) regarding the Safeware Chromebook insurance policy. While voluntary, with parts and device replacement costs increasing, I strongly urge everyone to take advantage of this

program. As noted in the PDF, this insurance/repair plan covers your CEC issued Chromebook against:

Accidental Damage, Theft, Robbery, Burglary, Drops, Falls, Collisions, Cracked Screens, Liquid Spills, Submersion, Power Surge, Vandalism, Flood, and Fire and mechanical breakdowns."

The insurance premium is \$43.40/year (with a \$50.00/repair deductible) and may be purchased online using a credit card. Please click on the link below to access the login and purchasing instructions as well as answers to some frequently asked questions.

When purchasing an insurance policy you will need the "SERVICE TAG" number of the Chromebook for which you are purchasing insurance. The "SERVICE TAG" is 7 alphanumeric characters in length (i.e. C2EC023) and may be found on the bottom of the Chromebook.
