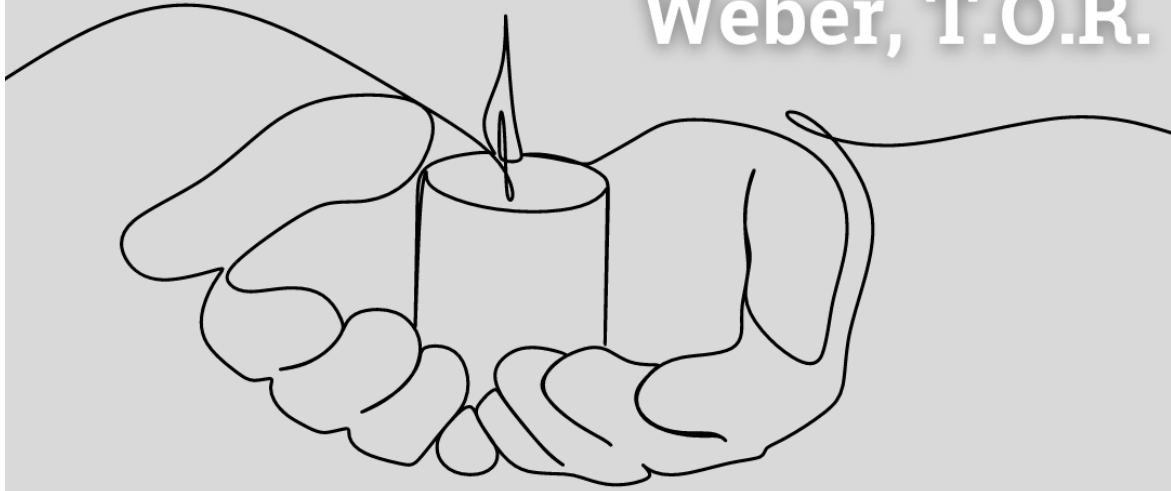

Junior League of Greater Princeton Scholarship

Awards scholarships to **female high school seniors** who have demonstrated a strong commitment to community service and voluntarism.
