- After completing their application, families will be provided options (mail, fax, or online upload) for submitting their supporting tax documents (most recent tax return; FACTS will contact families who do not file a tax return to confirm what documents they need to provide).
- 2021-2022 application is now open and awards are given on a rolling basis
- \$35 application fee per family
- Requires supporting documentation (most recent tax return)
