- Deadline: April 16, 2021
- Stop by the Counseling Center to get an application!

NAACP Scholarship

- The applicant must be a resident of Bucks County and must be a senior in high school with at least a 2.5 weighted G.P.A.
- Applicants must be applying to a four-year college or university program, a two-year associate degree program, or to a trade school
- Guidelines for applying are included in the application packet
- This year, three scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to deserving students
