**Honors ELA II Assignment:** In a 700-word essay, compare and contrast the main protagonist and the main antagonist in “Lord of the Flies” and “Fahrenheit 451”. What drives the protagonist to stand up for what they believe in? What presses the antagonist to “push their agenda”? Be specific and cite passages from the book that provides you with an insight into the character’s motivations.

**ELA II Assignment:** In a 700-word essay, write about the dynamic character that is “Piggy” and how he embodies many types of symbols for the novel, “Lord of the Flies”. For example, “Piggy” represents “the sacrificial lamb”, as well as “the conscience of humanity”. There are other interpretations and you are asked to discover them and back up your findings with specific citations of passages from the novel.
